


Parents, please read over and understand the MSC and event policies / rules.



Be safe, use common sense with masks and enjoy your time at the MSC.

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- When driving into the parking lot, GO SLOW and follow signs. Be aware of kids running though the parking lot!
- MKE Sting follows all guidelines and directives put out from the CDC, local government and USAV when it comes to facility protocols.
- Use hand sanitizer when entering the facility, frequently throughout your visit, and when you exit. ALL players should have their own supply of hand sanitizer with them.
- Restrooms are open. People can wash hands here with soap and water.
- Bring your own full water bottle and DO NOT bring any outside food into the building. Full concessions are available. Small wrapped snacks are permitted.
- Players are required to keep their bag and gear inside their assigned team zones inside the gym.
- Teams will NOT switch sides of the court in-between sets.
- FREE parking in the north and south lots. Please do not park in the assigned staff parking spots. Violators will be towed.
- · Be kind & considerate of others at all times.
- Players ... leave the bleacher seating for spectators. Spectators ... please allow the bleachers to be occupied by the teams playing on that court.
- Players keep their bags and gear in the team racks upstairs in the mezzanine area.



HEALTHY & CLEAN

Wash hands or use hand sanitizer prior to entering the MSC.



INTERNET ACCESS

24 hr internet access is available for purchase at \$5 to allow for personal live streaming.



NO FOLD UP CHAIRS

Personal fold up chairs are not allowed for this event.
We need to keep the walkways and view areas clear for spectators.



ARE YOU SICK?

Showing signs of being sick? Please stay home and get healthy.



Parking is FREE, but we ask that you park between the nines and leave room for others to park. Tailgating is allowed but teams will be penalized if their area is not cleaned up.

That pesky Covid-19 virus is still running rampant in the community - Waukesha County is rated having very high case activity with an increasing caseload. We want to host events so that all the young athletes are able to [play volleyball and we want all our guests at the MSC to be safe. So we have adopted the following policies, incorporating guidance from the CDC and the Waukesha County Health Department:



VACCINATED & UNVACCINATED GUESTS

Regardless of vaccination status, ALL spectators and guests are expected to wear a proper mask while attending this event. We thank you for doing your part to help make a safe and healthy playing environment for the kids.



PLAYERS & COACHES

ALL players and coaches are expected to wear a proper mask when not engaged in competition at the court and bench area. During competition players and coaches can choose not to wear their masks. WE WILL NOT SWITCH SIDES OF THE COURT IN-BETWEEN SETS. Referee work team MUST mask up.



FEELING SICK

Anyone who is sick is prohibited from entering the building. Anyone who has not been vaccinated and who has been in recent close contact with someone who tested positive for the Covid-19 virus is prohibited from entering the building.



CHILDREN UNDER 10

Regardless of vaccination status or age, ALL children under the age of 10 MUST mask up while attending this event. If your child has a problem keeping their mask on , please do not bring your child to this event. We thank you for doing your part to help make a safe and healthy playing environment for the kids.

Enforcement - The requirement to wear a mask if shall be enforced by the MSC staff. Any players, coach or spectator not complying with any MSC policy or rules is subject to forfeiture of competition results and or removal from the MSC.

We thank you for your anticipated cooperation.

MSC EVENT & FACILITY RULES

- 1. Players are NOT allowed any sort of ball-play against the walls inside the gym. Players are also asked not to bounce or toss volleyballs up into the ceiling areas over the courts, Players who cannot comply with these facility rules risk a deduction of points on their team's next game or a possible forfeiture of the the team's next set.
- 2. No carry-in food or coolers are allowed in the the MSC facility. Players are allowed to bring in their own snacks within reason and are asked to throw away their garbage. Healthy concessions are available.
- 3. No gum is allowed in the MSC facility.
- 4. No coffee cups or open face drinks allowed on the bench! Drinks must have caps. IF your coffee is hit by a volleyball or spilled, YOU are responsible for cleaning it up ... this includes coaches.
- 5. Teams are expected to bring their own volleyballs and carts for warm-ups.
- 6. Spectators are NOT allowed near the players bench area or on the floor at any time during the tournament. This means no video cameras from parents or coaches allowed on the playing surface. Please do not walk on the courts or cut though corners of courts. Please walk around courts for safety!
- 7. Fold up chairs or stools are **NOT ALLOWED** inside the MSC right now. Spectators may sit in the designated bleacher area or stand to view matches. **Please do not take the chairs from the team bench area**.
- 8. The MSC is "SMOKE-FREE" facility and there is no smoking allowed within 100 ft of the building.
- 9. The MSC is a "ALCOHOL-FREE" facility. Alcohol is not allowed on the property during junior volleyball events.
- 10. Please help keep the facility clean and throw away your trash in the garbage cans.

PLAYERS, COACHES or SPECTATORS

ABUSING THESE RULES IN THE MSC FACILITY WILL BE PENALIZED POINTS.

- 1st offense = team will forfeit 5 points on next set
- 2nd offense = team will forfeit entire next set (25pts)
- 3rd offense = team will be removed from the tournament and the facility
 Outside food found in the GYM will be confiscated by staff and team will be penali
